## NORTH SCHUYLKILL SCHOOL DISTRICT Parent & Family Engagement Policy

The North Schuylkill School District will involve parents in regular, two-way and meaningful communication addressing student achievement and ensuring:

  - o providing parents with information on state standards, assessments, requirements of Title I, monitoring their child's progress, and working with educators

  - o coordinating parent involvement activities with other initiatives including Head Start, after school programs, etc.

This District Parental & Family Engagement Policy has been developed jointly with, and agreed upon with parents of children participating in Title I, Part A programs, Title I staff, and North Schuylkill School District Administration.

This policy was adopted by the North Schuylkill School District during the spring of 2025. It will be in effect for the period of one school year. The school district will distribute this policy to all parents of participating Title I, Part A children.
